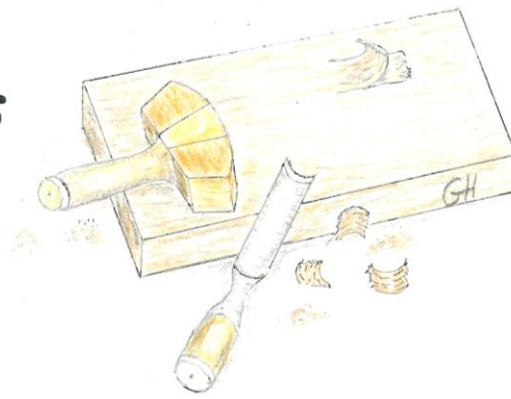


# Peninsula Woodworkers Club

The Fey Road mill has cutoffs available in various species.

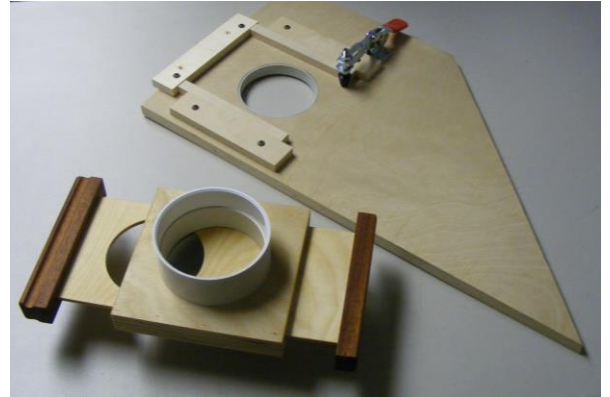
Angeles Millwork now offers discounts to club members.

Jonathan White built the fittings and blast gates for his dust control system. He said his place looks like a spider's web.

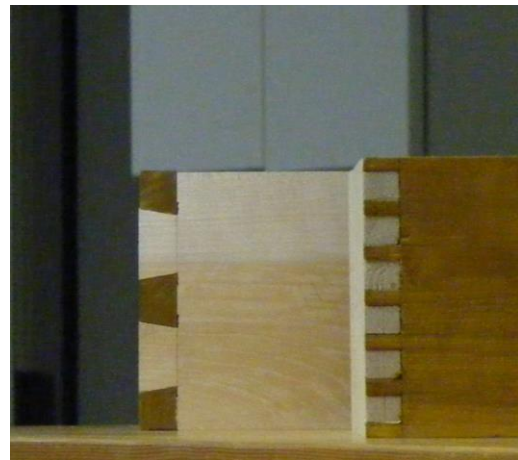


Rachael Boyd made a table from salvaged ship-lap fir. It is finished with shellac.

## ROUND TABLE

Jon Cash led a round table discussion on dovetail joints using a dovetail math formula. He gave out a sheet showing the formula with an example on it.

He also discussed laying out the pins using a pair of dividers to lay out a couple of trials until you get what you want.



## DOVETAIL SPACING FORMULA

FORMULA  $(PW * (N+1)) + (TW * N) = OW$

N = NUMBER OF TAILS

PW = PIN WIDTH MEASURED ON THE OUTSIDE

TW = TAIL WIDTH MEASURED ON THE OUTSIDE

OW = OVERALL WIDTH

## EXAMPLE

$N = 6, PW = 3/8", OW = 5 7/8"$

$(.375 * (6+1)) + (TW * 6) = 5.875$

$2.625 + 6TW = 5.875$

$6TW = 3.25$

$TW = .5416666$
